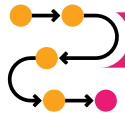


ACTION GAMES



STEPS

Peter Pan is an interactive play. We will play different games relating to numbers and actions. Here you have options to play with the children:

1. Number - Action

With the children, establish that each number has an action. For example: when you say number one, they have to jump. Introduce different instructions little by little. You can use: run, swim, fly, jump, turn around, clap...

2. Simon Says

Play the classic Simon Says game. You just have to say: "Simon Says jump" and the children have to do it. Introduce different instructions each time.

3. Make a group

Ask the children to find a space. At some point the teacher has to say: "Make a group of + number". The children make groups with the number of people required
